



Job title: Clinical Director, Home of Hope

Job purpose: The Clinical Director is responsible for the overall treatment program at Home of Hope and the administration of clinical services.

Home of Hope is a state-licensed Residential Treatment Center for girls age 8-17 who have been victims of sex trafficking and other forms of sexual exploitation. They receive 24-hour care and supervision by Direct Care staff, and treatment services by professional staff. The residence is a ranch on beautiful acreage, with animals that enhance the healing process for residents.

We are seeking a Clinical Director with a minimum of one year working in a residential program related to helping this population.

Duties and responsibilities:

- Responsible for all aspects of the treatment program, providing clinical and administrative oversight of all therapeutic interventions.
- Directly responsible for providing treatment services and supervising and directing the work of all clinical staff, including therapists, case managers, and contract providers.
- Approves initial treatment plans, and ongoing service plans for all residents, ensure that resident's clinical needs are met.
- Provides direct clinical services to residents, including but not limited to individual, group and family therapy.
- Completes written documentation of ongoing treatment of residents and progress through discharge
- Assists with in-service training of Direct Care Staff.
- Provides crisis intervention
- Available after hours for on-call emergencies

Qualifications:

- Psychiatrist, Psychologist, or individual with a master's degree in a human services field from an accredited college or university.
- Licensed Clinical Social Worker (LCSW), a Licensed Professional Counselor (LPC), or a Licensed Marriage and Family Therapist, with three years' experience providing treatment services for trafficking victims or children with an emotional disorder, including one year in a residential setting.

Working conditions:

- Working with challenging residents
- Schedule hours according to the resident's availability and need
- Full time employee with eligibility for benefits including PTO, health, dental, and vision insurance
