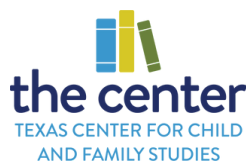

# Caring for High-Risk Youth and Child Victims of Sex Trafficking

**Child-serving professionals and foster families have critical roles to play in recognizing, responding, and preventing the commercial sexual exploitation of youth, often referred to as child sex trafficking.**
